### Part 1- Class Projects and Assignments...(written)

- Pinhole camera project-Process, technique and supplies
- Digital Photo shoot
- Composition and Shot Types
- Photomontage project-Process, technique and supplies
- Photoshop Elements 7.0 tools from the toolbox and define what they do
- File types: JPG and PSD- how are they different
- Layers vs. no layers in Photoshop
- Composite image project-Process, technique and supplies
- Logo Design-basics of good design-Process, technique and supplies
